## Grand Re-Opening of Belvoir Federal's School Branch

The Dolphin Branch re-opens every school year in October to provide students, faculty, and staff the convenience of having a credit union directly on school property and to promote financial literacy to students.

The Dolphin Branch is operated by 6<sup>th</sup> graders who perform teller duties. Each student teller is selected based on their exceptional skills shown in their mathematics classes. Since every student is eligible for membership, the student tellers are able to learn the operational side of how a credit union is run and the student members discover the fundamentals of saving money.

Mrs. Wilson, Principal of Fort Belvoir Elementary School, is a strong supporter of students having the opportunity to gain financial literacy insight at an early age. The coordinator at Fort Belvoir Elementary School, Teresa Chapman, and Belvoir Federal's South Post Branch Manager, Monika Plunkett, will be heading up the Dolphin Branch for the 2010-2011 school year.
